Become a lead school for a non-core subject.

ERW has received funding from Welsh Government to support schools to implement the changes to the GCSEs in non-core subjects for teaching in 2016 and 2017. As a result of this funding, we are now recruiting lead schools for each subject.

We have funding to allow for 3 lead schools per subject. This will be one lead school per hub where possible. Each lead school will receive funding of £3600 which will cover up to 20 days release for the lead teacher to support implementation and drive forward this work.

On these days lead teachers will be expected to:

- Work in collaboration with the three lead schools to support the implementation of the new GCSE
- Hold network meetings with their hub to allow heads of department to share and develop practice
- Develop resources or schemes of work as required to support the implementation
- Share most recent developments with all departments within their hub.
- Work with the ERW central team and Leader of Learning for Foundation subjects to develop support packages for teachers.
- Represent the Region at National events, where required.

Schools are welcome to apply for more than one subject.

Lead schools are required for the following subjects:

Geography, Music, Drama, Art and Design, Food and Nutrition, Physical Education, History, Religious Studies, Design and Technology, Business, Computer Science and Media Studies
